IH: Bit, Sit



AYE: Pay, Late



EH: Bet, Set



AE: Land, Black



AH: Pop, Heart



AW: Song, Dawn



OH: Boat, Grow



OO: Good, Book



OO: Moon, Tune



UR: Learn, Word



UH: Love, Sun



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
